This beguiling Islander, a bourbon-matured whisky, once selected and vatted went on a mysterious voyage of discovery with a period of further refinement in French wine casks (Grenache) to rock some traditionally sacred whisky beliefs - in true Bruichladdich style: maturing whisky in wine casks; drinking a fine single malt with ice; marrying older with younger ages.

Tasting Note :

Soft red grapes, red currant jelly, pomegranate and red apple all encased in an envelope of syrup, sweet malted barley and brown sugar vanilla. The wine flavours wait patiently while the malt and oak display their charms – then given time they emerge bringing red cherry, strawberry and spiciness. It has a yogurt like texture, really creamy yet still retains Islay's snappy coastal briny sea breeze .
Outrageously drinkable!

Wine Match :

Rich yet crisp; fresh and creamy, almost buttery. Makes you think of a cool climate chardonnay from somewhere like the Mornington Peninsula, Margaret River, Hawkes Bay, North Willamette Valley, Niagara Peninsula or even the Sonoma Ridgetops.
