## 125th Anniversary

Vintage 1970 - 35 Years Old

To celebrate the 125th Anniversary of the distillery, only the best will do. 1970 was a great vintage for Bruichladdich. The previous bottling won the award for the Single Malt of the Year.

This time, surprisingly for some, exceptional and rare casks from Alsace's Domaine Zind Humbrecht were used in a daring Additional Cask Evolution to supplement the American oak flavours.

By elevating an already excellent whisky into the realms of dreams, the *Selection de Grains Noble* Pinot Gris casks, that contained a decadently rich 100 pointer wine, have given us a sensational dram worthy of such a special occasion.

**Taste Descriptors: Nectarine, paw paw, honeydew, passion fruit, mango, guava, marzipan, candy floss, black cherry, banana and Madeira cake.**

Limited edition release of only 2,500 bottles. 1970 whisky matured for 35 years in bourbon casks and then ACE'd in Zind Humbrecht *Selection de Grains Noble* Pinot Gris Alsace white wine casks - one of a handful of wines to score 100/100 points in The Wine Spectator. Casks coopered by the legendary Dominic Laurent. ACE - Additional Cask Evolution adds subtle layers of flavours from other casks to compliment the flavours that developed in the original cask. Re-release of the acclaimed Vintage 1970 which was voted the 2003 Import Malt of the Year by U.S. Malt Advocate. Islay bottled at Natural Cask Strength without colouring or chill-filtration.

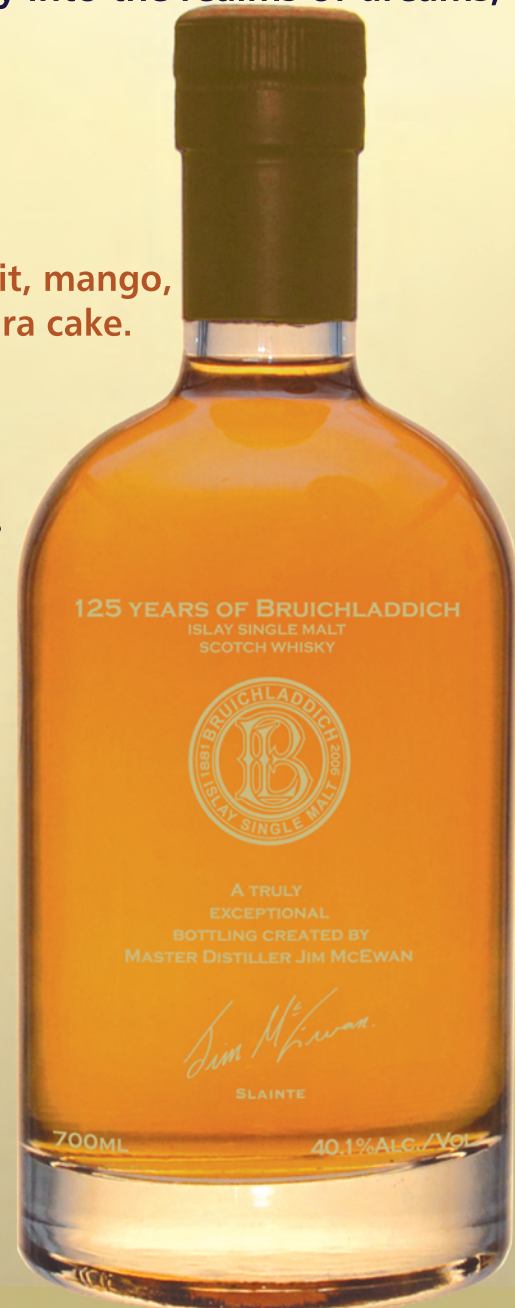
