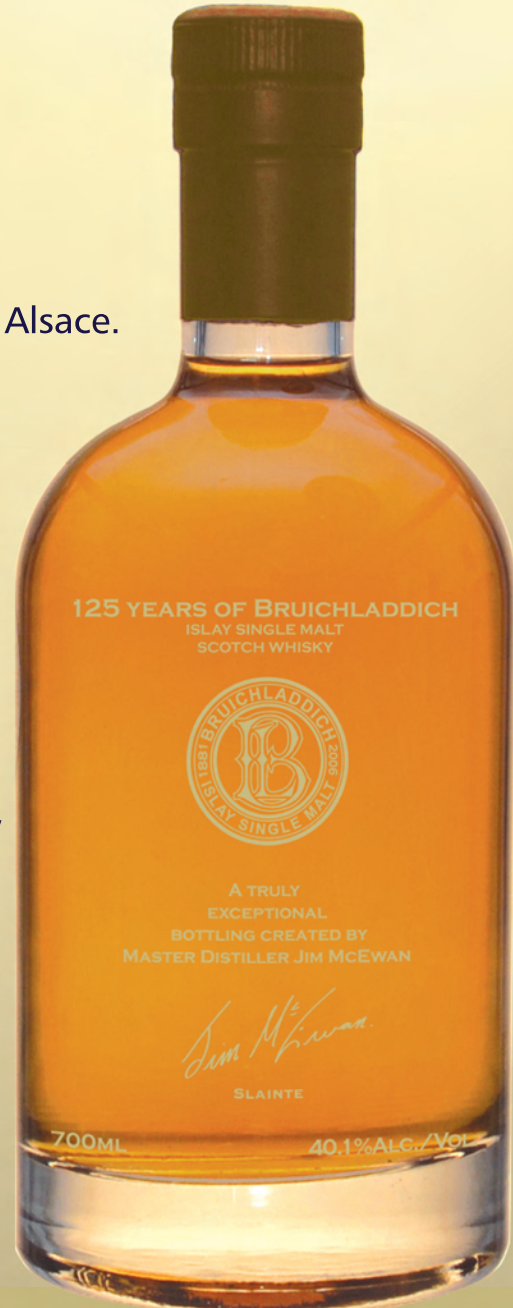

### TASTING NOTE



Cask  Bourbon

Ace  Zind Humbrecht Selection de Grains Noble Pinot Gris Alsace.

Colour  Luminous Marigold/Golden Yellow.

Body  The texture is as soft as swansdown and glides over the senses like you have never experienced. This is the ultimate Class in a Glass!

Nose  Wow! At this age no whisky should be so intensely aromatic, it's incredible. Nectarine, cantaloupe, honeydew, pawpaw, passion fruit, mango and guava all seem to have come together in a starburst of soft fruit. The mellowness of the American oak surrounds and embraces the fruit. Vanilla, marzipan and coconut milk and the sweet honeyed aromas of oak. Its all crystallised fruit and candy floss. The extra time spent in Olivier's Pinot Gris casks bring aromas of cherry and strawberry adding new and exciting olfactory experiences. The malty notes have been totally seduced by the fruit and have taken on the aroma of soft banana/Madeira cake – Absolutely amazing!

Palate  Full bodied, full flavoured, well matured, mellow, generous with a rich raciness. All the amazing aromas found are illuminated on the palate with the oak leading strong and trustworthy. The Islay maturation has also added a fresh citrus element which brings a sherbet fizz to the taste. Its single malt serendipity – The Crème de la Crème.

Finish  This beauty does not finish - it drifts gently, long into the night.
